

IMMIGRATION DISCOURSES: THE CASE OF ROMANIAN IMMIGRANTS IN ITALY

Abstract:

Next, I will comment on the findings of the surveys carried out by Metro Media Transilvania and commissioned by Agenția pentru strategii guvernamentale: Comunitatea românească în Italia: condiții sociale, valori, așteptări - Studiu sociologic (December 2007) and Percepția cetățenilor italieni asupra României și comunității românești din Italia (March-April 2008). Last but not least, I will focus on media discourses on the issue of Romanian immigrants in Italy, as seen in the English-speaking media.
